Warradarge Wind Farm Community Grants Empowering the Community

Four community organisations in the Shires of Carnamah and Coorow will benefit from the 2023 Warradarge Wind Farm Community Grants.

Run by Bright Energy Investments, the grants of up to \$5000 support a wide range of initiatives that make a real and tangible difference in the community.

General Manager, Tom Frood, said the grants were part of Bright Energy Investments' commitment to local communities.

"We invest in the communities in which we operate because we want to contribute to an inclusive and sustainable future," Mr Frood said.

The 2023 grant recipients were:

- **St Johns Ambulance Leeman and Green Head Sub-Centre** – to purchase high-pressure washers to clean the ambulance.
- **Green Head Community Association** – to purchase shade sails for the community hall playground.

Green Head Community Association Secretary Patricia Williams said the shade sails would make a huge difference for the centre.

"It means our children will have a sun safe play area all year round and will encourage community engagement in our activities," Ms Williams said.
