Our Warradarge team are making significant progress with the installation of the concrete footings for our latest windfarm project in conjunction with [Vestas](#), for [Bright Energy Investments](#). With approximately 470 cubes of concrete – which equates to roughly 30 suburban homes – and 60 tonnes of steel in each footing, the pours take around nine and a half hours from start to finish! The turbines will be among the largest in Western Australia with a tip height of 152 metres, sporting some of the longest blades in the country, stretching up to 66 metres. With the trenching and install of HV cables happening on site, the team is firmly on-track to deliver one of the country's newest renewable projects in the coming year.
